The contradiction is resolved when you realize that for Jesus peace seems to have meant not the absence of struggle, but the presence of love.



our program. Work Day on July 26th.



HAYDAY! GROWING IN FRIENDSHIP WITH JESUS **VBS 2022**






The volunteer choir sang a traditional Hymn from the OSB during our June 12 Worship service. Thank you to those that come and share their music gifts. It truly makes our worship special.

High Achievers at the Jefferson County Fair




Many of the Youth in our Church participated in the
